Comment

Number of bovines as at 30 June 2025 decreased by 5.0 thousand heads (-0.3%) y-o-y, of which number of other cows increased by 8.1 thousand heads (+3.6%) and number of dairy cows decreased by 21.4 thousand heads (-5.9%). Compared with the number as at 31 December 2024 the number of bovines increased by 3.3%, of which other cows grew up by 6.4% and number of dairy cows went down by 4.9%.

Milk production reached the level of 1 700.8 mil. litres in the 1st half-year (-3.7%) y-o-y. Average daily milk yield 27.68l rose by 3.9%. 57.6 calves were born per 100 cows (+1.2%) y-o-y and 54.2 calves were reared. Losses of claves less than 3 months old related to the total number of calves were 5.9% (0.0 % points). Marketability of milk was 97.5%. Production of cattle for slaughter grew up by 3.3 thousand tonnes in live weight (+3.8%) y-o-y.
