Comment

Number of bovines as at 30 June 2025 decreased by 5.0 thousand heads (-0.3%) y-o-y, of which number of other cows increased by 7.9 thousand heads (+3.5%) and number of dairy cows decreased by 21.2 thousand heads (-5.8%). Compared with the number as at 31 December 2024 the number of bovines increased by 3.3%, of which other cows grew up by 6.3% and number of dairy cows went down by 4.8%.

Milk production reached the level of 1 702.1 mil. litres in the 1st half-year (-3.6%) y-o-y. Average daily milk yield 27.67l rose by 3.8%. 57.6 calves were born per 100 cows (+1.2%) y-o-y and 54.2 calves were reared. Losses of claves less than 3 months old related to the total number of calves were 5.9% (0.0 % points). Marketability of milk was 97.5%. Production of cattle for slaughter grew up by 3.2 thousand tonnes in live weight (+3.8%) y-o-y.
