State budget

• State budget surplus in relation to GDP 2.1%

In the 1.Q 2006, the state budget execution ended with a surplus of CZK 15.8 bn, which was inter-annually higher by CZK 7.5 bn. Not only was the flow of budgetary revenue (26.7%) higher than expenditure (23.0%), also the revenue excess over expenditure increased. The inter-annual increase of revenue (CZK 29.1 bn.) was higher than the one of expenditure (CZK 21.6 bn). The budget surplus to GDP was 2.1%, what is Inter-annually better result by 0.9 p.p.

• Tax revenue growth

Tax revenue (9.4 p.p.) had the decisive influence on budgetary revenue, which increased by 11.0%, out of which tax revenue excluding social security by 13.6%. Non-tax and capital revenues and obtained grants increased by one third, their growth, however, declined; they contributed to the total growth by 4.7 p.p. The tax share on GDP increased inter-annually. The increase of operating expenditure by 9.3% (9.0 p.p.), out of which social benefits 4.7 p.p., influenced total expenditure at most. The rest was due to the considerable increase of capital expenditure (62.2%), out of which particularly investment purchases and connected outlays.
