50 YEARS OF PRAGUE METRO IN DATES

| 9. 5. 1974 | Operation was started on the first line C in the section Kačerov – Sokolovská (today's Florenc). |
| 12. 8. 1978 | Operation started on the 1st section of line A from Náměstí Míru to Dejvická (former Lenínova). |
| 2. 11. 1985 | Operation started on the 1st section of line B from Smíchovské nádraží to Florenc (former Sokolovská). |
| 12.-16. 8. 2002 | During the flood, a large part of tracks and stations was flooded. The operation of sections and stations was restored gradually after demanding reconstructions until March 22, 2003. |
| 6. 4. 2015 | The extension of metro A from Dejvická to Nemocnice Motol was put into operation. This is the last extension of Prague metro so far. |
| 19. 6. 2019 | Geological survey for the fourth line D of Prague metro in the section Pankrác–Nové Dvory started. Its buildings will become part of the new D line in the future. |
