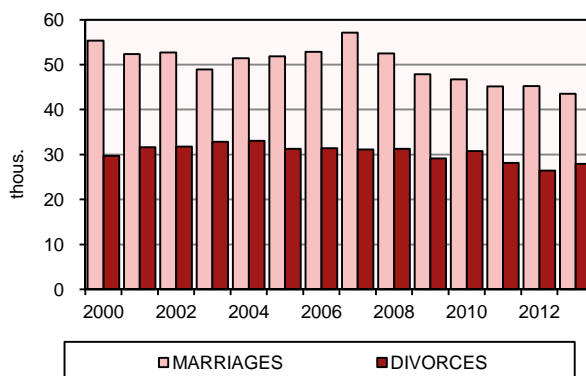

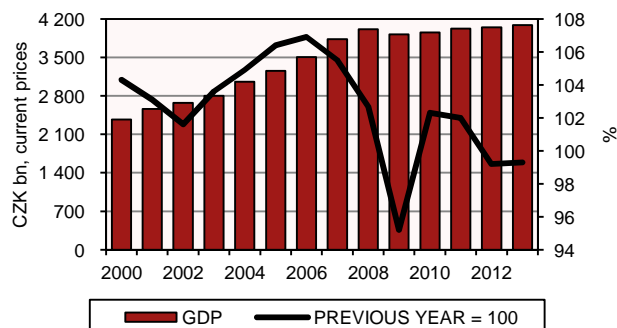

### SHARE OF UNEMPLOYED PERSONS

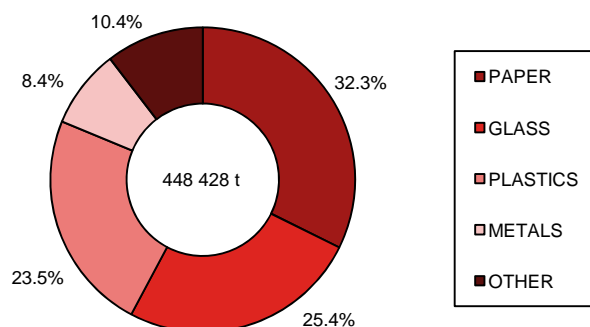

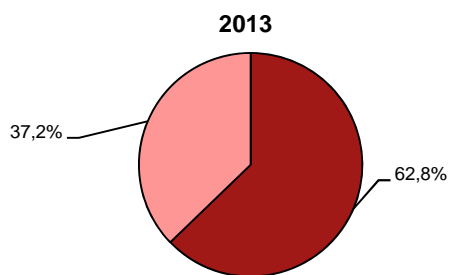

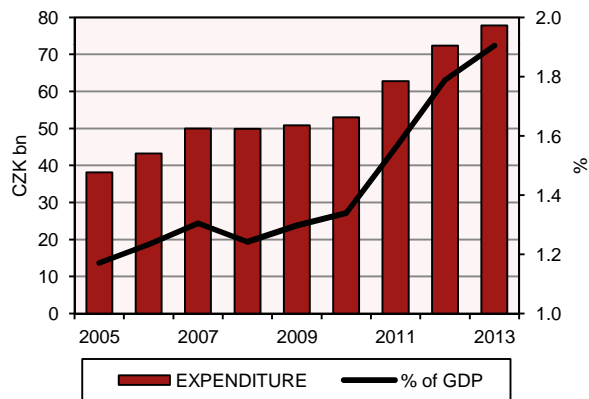

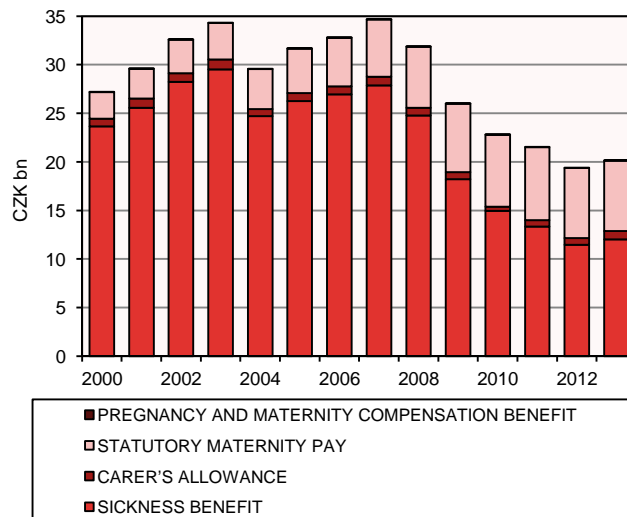
### PATIENTS' EXPENDITURE ON REGULATION FEES

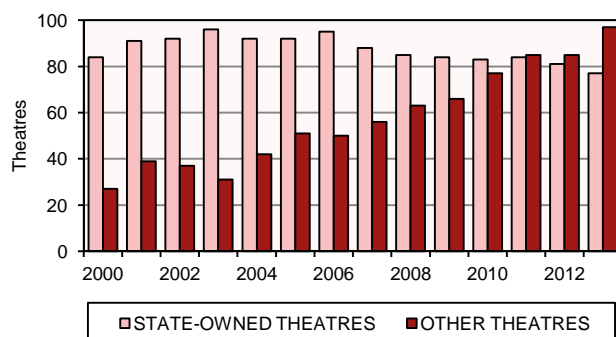

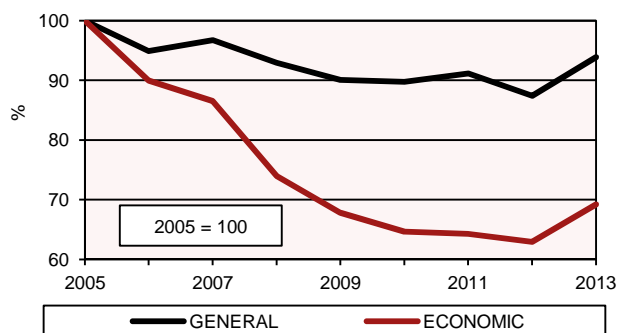
