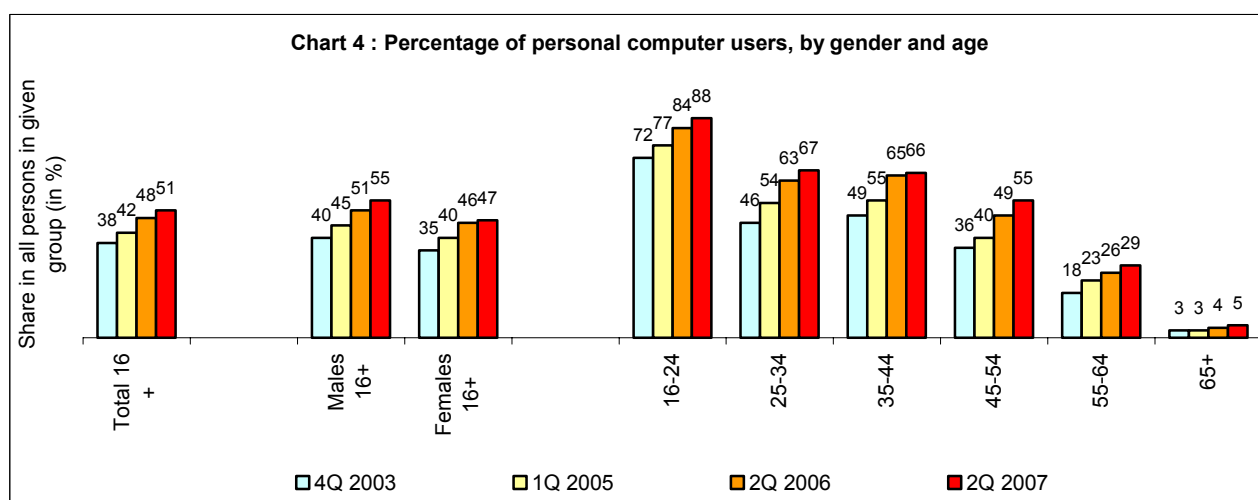


II.2. USE OF PERSONAL COMPUTER BY INDIVIDUALS

- 59% of population aged 16+ (5,1 mil. individuals) have ever used personal computer
- 51% of population aged 16+ (4,4 mil. individuals) are PC users (used a personal computer in the last 3 months).

Definition: *person who used a personal computer in the last 3 months is considered as a personal computer user (survey was carried out in the 2nd quarter 2007).*

- There are quite big differences in PC usage by age and education.
- Usage of PC is popular especially among students (97% of students are PC users) and among persons in the age group 16-24 (88%).
- On the other hand, there is only 5% of individuals aged 65+ who are PC users.
- 89% of PC users are regular users (3,9 mil. individuals, 45% of population aged 16+) – they work with PC at least once a week.
- 61% of PC users use PC every day or nearly every day
- 82% of PC users use PC at home, 48% at work and 18% at school.
