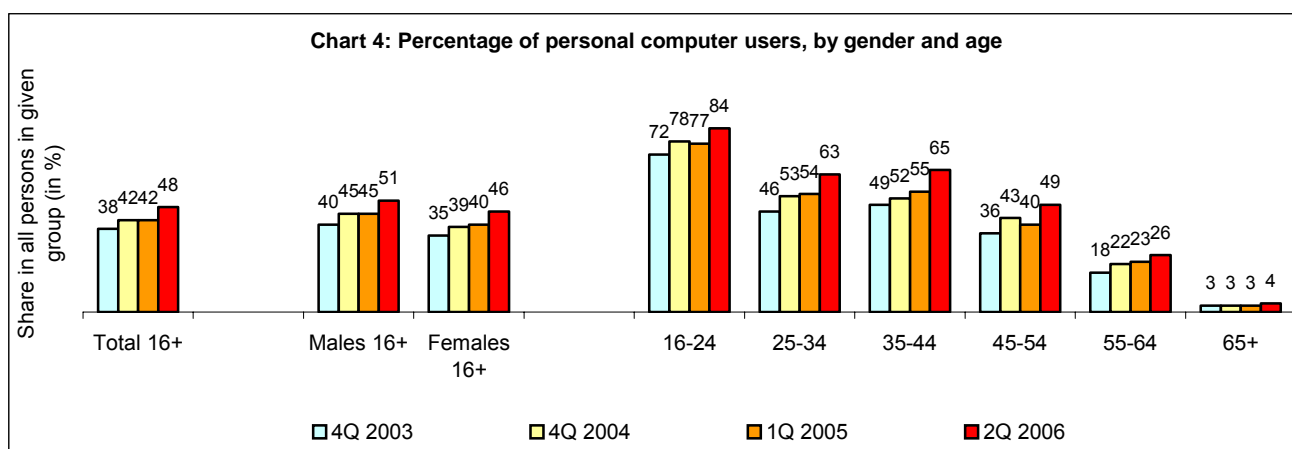


## II.2. USE OF PERSONAL COMPUTER BY INDIVIDUALS

- 56% of population aged 16+ (4,85 mil. individuals) have ever used personal computer
- 48% of population aged 16+ (4,14 mil. individuals) used a personal computer in the last 3 months

**Definition:** *person who used a personal computer in the last 3 months is considered as a personal computer user (survey was carried out in the 2nd quarter 2006).*

- There are quite big differences in PC usage by age and education.
- Usage of PC is popular especially among students (97% of them are PC users), persons with university degree (83%) and among persons in the age group 16-24 (84%).
- On the other hand, there is only 4% of individuals aged 65+ who are PC users.
- 86% of PC users are regular users (3,57 mil. individuals, 41% of population aged 16+) – they work with PC at least once a week.
- 57% of PC users use PC every day or nearly every day
- 78% of PC users used PC (in the last 3 months) at home, 49% at work and 19% at school.
