¹ Data on income transactions with the rest of the world are estimated on the basis of the data from the Balance of Payment of the CSFR and the official share of the CR from 1992.

² Gross domestic income in current prices is numerically identical with gross domestic product, because it is the income counterparty of the production process. It is the income, that was produced by all residents units, i.e. including enterprises under foreign control and without distribution process, while gross national income is a result of primary distribution and then it is reduced / increased by outflow / inflow of primary income to / from abroad.

³ Acquisition of non-produced assets by the rest of the world is seen as a source for national economy, therefore it is in the summary of net capital transfers included with the inverse sign.
