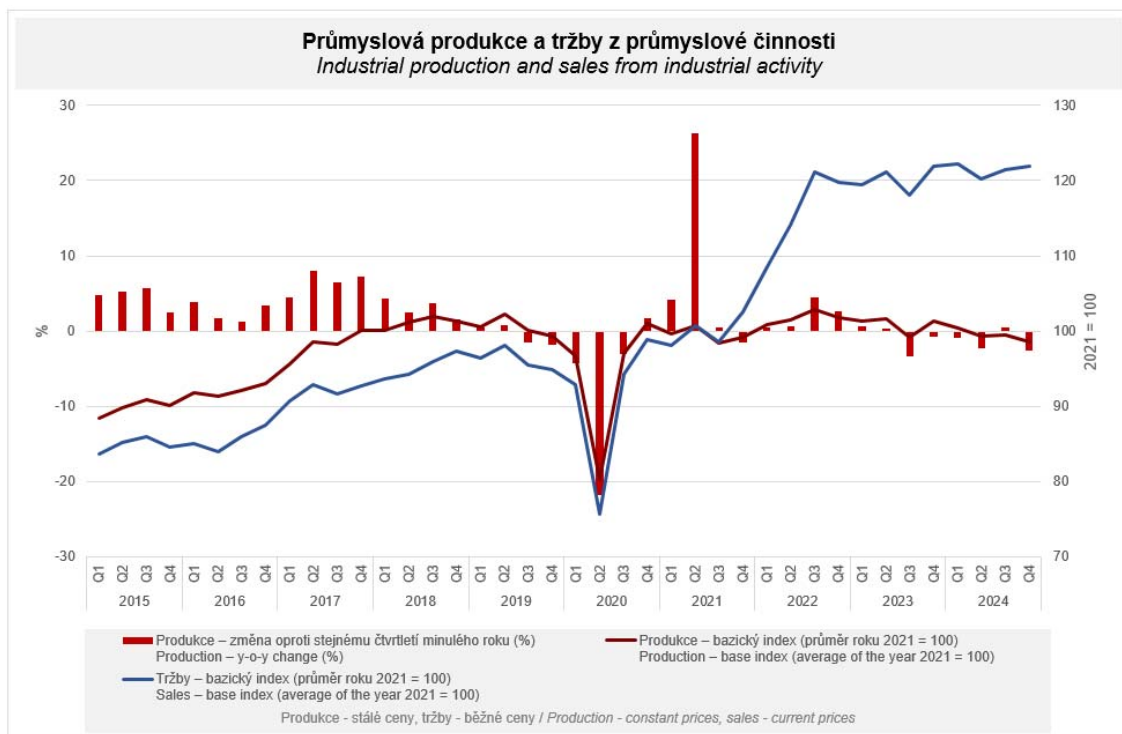

Industrial production decreased by 1.4% in 2024

Supplementary information to the news release on industry – December 2024

Industry in the year 2024

Industrial production was by 1.4% lower, year-on-year, (y-o-y) in 2024. In the year 2024, there were by two working days more compared to the year 2023. Manufacture of machinery and equipment contributed the most to the decrease of industrial production. The production dropped there by 10.2%, year-on-year (the contribution to the decrease of the industry in total was -0.80 percentage point (p. p.)). The following also decreased: manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (a contribution of -0.44 p. p., a decrease by 2.3%) and manufacture of basic metals (a contribution of -0.26 p. p., a decrease by 8.3%). Coal mining decreased by 12%, y-o-y. On the other hand, the highest positive contributions were recorded in the following: manufacture of food products (a contribution of +0.17 p. p., an increase by 3.5%), other manufacturing (a contribution of +0.11 p. p., an increase by 5.3%), and manufacture of paper and paper products (a contribution of +0.08 p. p., an increase by 4.6%).

In the first quarter, the industrial production decreased by 0.9%, y-o-y. In the second quarter, the decrease rate further accelerated: compared to the Q2 2023, the industrial production dropped by 2.2%. After stagnation or rather a black zero in the third quarter, industry returned to a decrease in the end of the year. In the **fourth quarter** of 2024, the industrial production decreased by 2.6%, y-o-y. Compared to the previous quarter, it decreased by 0.9%. Those results were the most influenced by manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, in which production decreased by 6.5%, compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, namely in the part of the economic activity focusing on manufacture of parts and accessories for motor vehicles. The same as in the previous quarters, the demand continued to decrease in manufacture of machinery and equipment.

Sales from industrial activity at current prices increased by 0.9%, y-o-y, in 2024. Direct export sales of industrial enterprises increased at current prices by 1.6%. Domestic sales, which also include indirect export via non-industrial enterprises, increased at current prices by 0.1%.

The following contributed the most to the growth: manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (a contribution of +0.8 p. p., an increase by 3.2%), manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (a contribution of +0.5 p. p., an increase by 10.2%), and manufacture of rubber and plastic products (a contribution of +0.2 p. p., an increase by 3.0%).

On the other hand, sales from industrial activity decreased the most in the following: manufacture of machinery and equipment (a contribution of -0.44 p. p., a decrease by 6.3%), manufacture of basic metals (a contribution of -0.43 p. p., a decrease by 12.3%), and mining and quarrying (a contribution of -0.2 p. p., a decrease by 14.6%).

The value of **new orders** at current prices in surveyed industrial CZ-NACE activities in 2024 increased by 2.8%, year-on-year. Non-domestic new orders increased by 2.6%. Domestic new orders increased by 3.2%.

The following contributed the most to the increase of the value of new orders: manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (a contribution of +1.8 p. p., an increase by 4.8%), manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (a contribution of +0.8 p. p., an increase by 9.5%), and manufacture of other transport equipment (contribution of +0.5 p. p., an increase by 24.3%). Negative contributions were recorded by manufacture of machinery and equipment (a contribution of -0.4 p. p., a decrease by 3.3%), manufacture of basic metals (a contribution of -0.6 p. p., a decrease by 11.5%), and by manufacture of textiles (a contribution of -0.03 p. p., a decrease by 1.8%).

The average registered number of **employees** in industry in 2024 was by 2.0% lower than the one in the corresponding period of the previous year and their average gross monthly nominal wage increased by 6.7%.
